



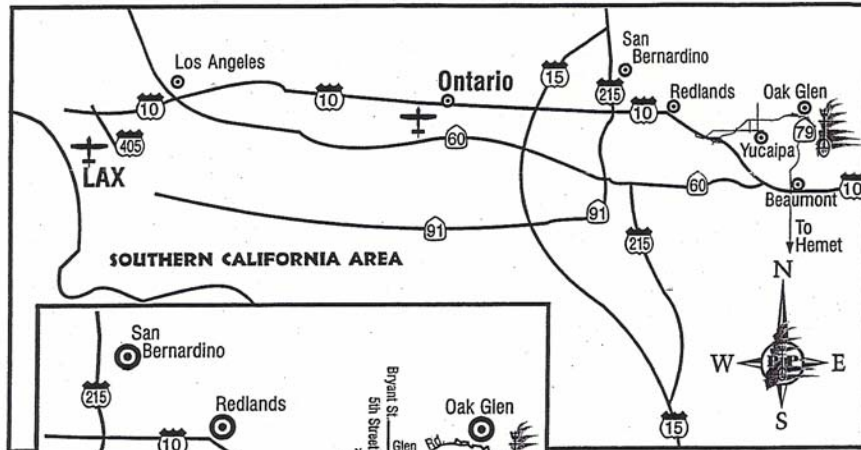

DIRECTIONS TO PILGRIM PINES



Pilgrim Pines is located 8 miles east of Yucaipa and 16 miles from Redlands on the southern slopes of the San Bernardino Mountains.

Traveling from WEST of Redlands: Drive EAST on the San Bernardino Freeway (I-10). Take the Yucaipa exit (just after the Ford Street exit past Redlands). Turn LEFT and take Yucaipa

Bld. 4 miles to 5th Street. Turn LEFT on 5th Street and continue to the dead end. Turn RIGHT on Oak Glen Road, continue for 7 miles and turn LEFT on Glen Road, about 3/4 mile past Oak Tree Village. There are signs on both sides of the road for Pilgrim Pines as you make the turn onto Glen Road. Drive up the hill 3/4 mile to parking lot. **WELCOME TO PILGRIM PINES!**

Bus and Train Station Directions: From the train station or bus station in San Bernardino, take the 215 Freeway SOUTH towards Riverside. At the interchange, take the San Bernardino Freeway (I-10) EAST. Continue to the Yucaipa exit and follow the directions listed above.

From the Ontario Airport: Take the San Bernardino Freeway (I-10) EAST. Continue to the Yucaipa exit and follow the directions listed above.

From the Los Angeles International Airport: Take the 405 Freeway NORTH to the 10 Freeway EAST. Travel through San Bernardino and Redlands to the Yucaipa exit and follow the directions listed above.

The First Congregational Church Women's Spirituality Retreat is a time for women to experience quiet, prayer, reflection and spiritual renewal in the beauty and relaxed atmosphere of the local mountains. It is also a time to build and renew friendships with women in our faith community.

The theme this year is *Remembering Your Story: Creating Your Own Spiritual Autobiography*. We'll share in some collective and individual reflection, and hopefully gain some tools with which we can connect to our deeper selves—tools which we can use not only at the retreat, but once we've come home, as well.

Women going to the retreat are encouraged to attend, if possible, the "Writing the Sacred" workshop at church on February 27. Those who are registered for the retreat will receive a \$5 discount on the cost of the workshop.

The retreat will begin on Friday evening, March 5, with supper at 5:30 p.m. and will end on Sunday morning, March 7 at 11 a.m.

We will be housed in Leadership Lodge, Hill House and the Health Center, which includes double, triple and quadruple occupancy with shared baths and some beds and some bunk beds. No single rooms are available. You can select your room when you turn in your registration.

The cost for the weekend is \$125, which includes housing, five meals, and all activities.

WHAT TO BRING CHECKLIST

- Bedding (sleeping bag or blankets and sheets), towel & washcloth, toilet articles, medications
- Comfortable, loose-fitting clothing, warm jacket, sturdy closed shoes
- A mat, cushion or towel for sitting on the floor
- Any instruments or tools that aid you in your spiritual practice
- A token or talisman for the altar (no candle)
- A copy of a favorite poem
- Four or five photos of yourself at different ages, up to the age you are now
- Writing utensils
- Anything you want for quiet time—reading or knitting, puzzles, camera, etc.
